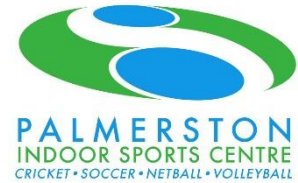


SIX-PAK INDOOR CRICKET RULE VARIATIONS



- Six players per team
- 18 overs per innings
- Each batting pair bats for 6 overs
- Each player bowls 1 over to each batting pair
- Court is divided into thirds by redlines - 2 fielders only in each third until bowler has released the ball
- Minus 6 runs for a wicket
- Batters can be caught off the back net if the ball hits the 13 square
- On the 3rd ball after the batters have played their shot, both batters must run. If either batter hesitates they shall be given out.
- The scoring zones are higher (see diagram).
- And the most important rule of all - the highest batting partnership for the game, regardless if you win or lose, receives a free six-pak of drinks from the bar/canteen.

Scoring Zones

A - 1 plus physical runs

B - 2 plus physical runs

C - 3 plus physical runs

D - 4 on the bounce, 6 on the full
plus physical runs

E - white squares on back net - 12 plus physical runs
but may be caught out (if caught, minus 6 runs)

F - Coca Cola sign - 20 plus physical runs but may be
caught out (if caught, minus 10 runs)
